### Welcome to New Farm Neighbourhood Centre

Since 1984, New Farm Neighbourhood Centre has provided connection and support for the local community. Located in Brunswick Street, opposite beautiful New Farm Park, we offer opportunities for people to come together around shared interests, and to meet and to connect with our community.

Our centre provides free help and connection with HART 4000 for housing support and emergency relief. If you are experiencing challenges in life around relationships, income, employment or your personal situation we can help with brief intervention, navigating services and financial inclusion programs. We also offer community engagement programs that can support participation and inclusion.

We encourage anyone to use our kitchen, laundry, shower and computer facilities, and we even have our own kitchen garden.

Everybody is welcome at our neighbourhood centre. The Centre is a shared space and we ask that visitors follow our guidelines of being inclusive and respectful. This ensures a safe and welcoming place for all who visit.

#### Open House

Our Centre provides a variety of activities as well as support services in a safe space, open to everyone. Visit us during drop-in hours to find out about our facilities and services and see what activities we have happening.

- Information & referral- drop-in or call us to ask for information about local services and support or book an appointment for a chat about how we can help.
- Shared meals- free breakfast and lunch is available.
- **Food relief-** supported by Second Bite, food packages are prepared and available for pick up on Mondays.
- **Computers-** computers are free to use and you can use our phone.
- **Laundry & showers-** are available for anyone to use. Towels and toiletries are available.
- **Library-** please borrow or contribute books to our free book exchange. Accessable 24/7 at front of centre.
- Financial Inclusion- we offer emergency relief and a No Interest Loan Scheme.
- Community coffee- buy your morning Merlo coffee from our community cafe, and shout someone else who needs it.
- **GP** Bulk Billed drop-in appointments with GP Nancy Sturman, Mondays and Thursdays.
- Physiotherapist- free drop-in sessions available Thursdays.
- Free Haircuts available- enquire at centre.
- Forms Assistance available- enquire at centre.
- Tax Help available- enquire at centre.

- English language class- available to all levels of learning, hosted by skilled volunteers on Wednesdays.
- Mens Group- promotes conversation, inclusion and personal development.
- **Meditation** free classes Tuesday evenings.
- Weaving Women- Tuesday mornings.
- Over 65's Social Groups- Wednesday mornings.
