Instructions

YOU WILL NEED

Cardboard – a cereal box or sheet of light cardboard
Scissors
Sticky tape
Glue stick
Coloured pens or pencils
Piece of scrap furry fabric or cotton wool ball



Before starting you might like to watch the 'How to make your Kangaroo' instruction video on the Communify website: <https://communify.org.au/>

- 1. LET'S GET STARTED** - Print the Kangaroo templates from the Communify website. You can print out on cardboard or glue later on to your cardboard
 - a. Colour in the kangaroo, pouch and stand.
 - b. Print out the hearts on plain paper. Write the names of special people who make you feel safe and protected on the hearts.
2. If not printed on a sheet of cardboard, glue the blank side of the Kangaroo and stand template onto the cardboard. {allow to dry}
- 3. THE KANGAROO** - cut out the Kangaroo
4. Stick the fur on the Kangaroo's tummy
5. Glue the grey area of the Kangaroo's tummy
6. Stick the Kangaroo's pouch on

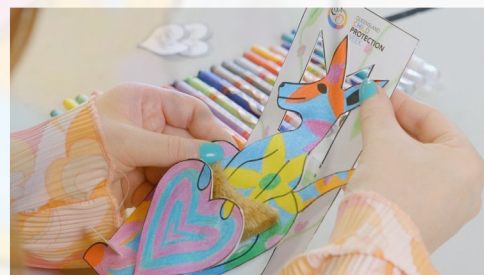

7. On the Kangaroo cut the dotted line to make a slit {this is for the stand to sit in}
8. **THE STAND** - Cut out the stand {Cut through the dotted lines to make cutting easier, once cut out, sellotape the dotted lines back together}
9. Fold the first bend line, and then unfold and fold the second bend line. This will make a small flat area
10. **ASSEMBLY** - Place the end of the stand through the cuts on the kangaroo
11. The bends make the base of the stand
12. Glue the back of the kangaroo's right ear onto the black dot on the stand
13. Your Kangaroo will now stand on her own
14. **FEELING SAFE** – Cut out the hearts, with the names of people who make you feel safe and protected and place into the Kangaroo's pouch

WELL DONE, YOU HAVE NOW MADE YOUR KANGAROO, GIVE HER A NAME AND KEEP HER SAFE WITH YOU.
