Crackerjack Attack is back again!

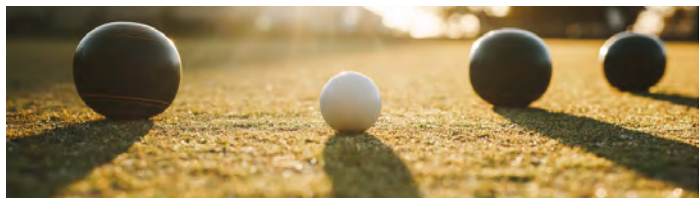
